Call for Expressions of Interest

In a 3 year strategic program, UNSW is increasing its staff numbers to invest in new academic talent. UNSW Law is offering opportunities for early career researchers to join Australia's leader in innovative legal education and progressive, engaged research. UNSW Law has a very distinctive character, inspired by our founding vision of legal education committed to law as a service profession, dedicated to fundamental principles of the rule of law and justice for all.

Commencing in 2012 UNSW Law will offer up to two strategically funded positions at level B or C, each for three years initially with provision for conversion to a continuing appointment.

We are seeking expressions of interest in the form of a brief research outline and curriculum vitae, from suitably qualified early career researchers. Candidates will need to demonstrate excellent research performance (preferably via external grants or publication in leading journals) and potential, and a strong commitment to interactive and experiential teaching suited to UNSW Law's benchmark-setting new curriculum to be introduced in 2013.
