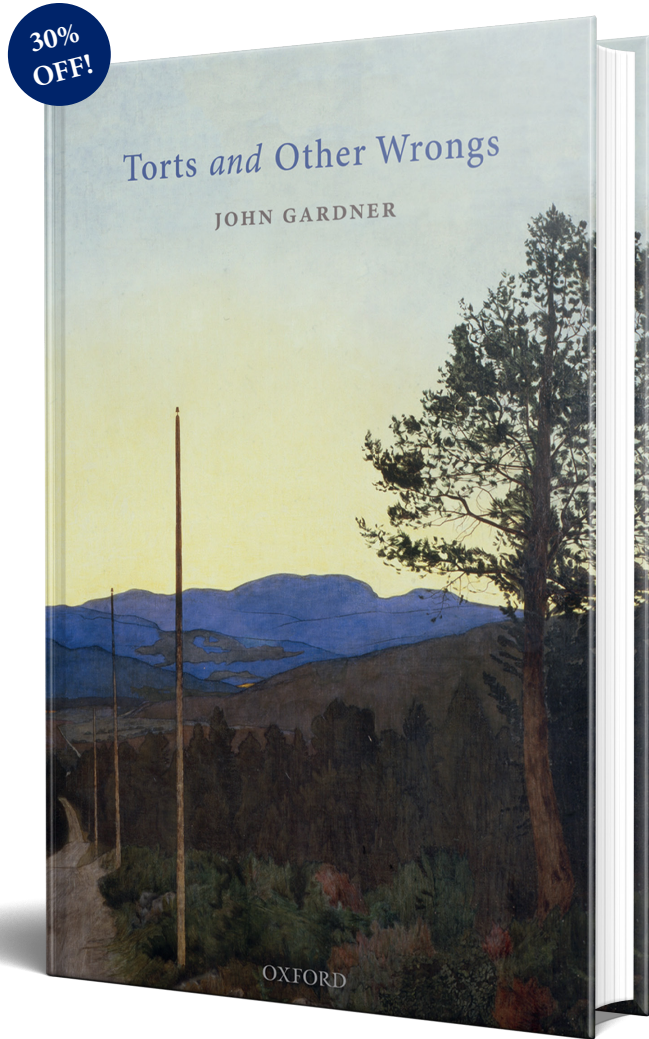


# TORTS AND OTHER WRONGS
